

- By MRT (Taipei Metro) —
- 1. Take MRT Line 2 (Red) and get off at the Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station.
- 2. Take MRT Line 5 (Blue) and get off at the Taipei City Hall Station. Then walk to the TWTC Exhibition Hall 1, which takes about 13 minutes, or take bus routes 537 or Blue 5 at Taipei City Hall Station to reach the TWTC Exhibition Hall 1.
- By Taxi —

Taxis are convenient in Taipei and fares are reasonable. The base fare is NT\$70, increasing by increments of NT\$5 per 250m with an NT\$20 surcharge added from 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM per trip.


